Course Description:

Corruption happens. Your Active Directory can be damaged through cyberattacks, ransomware, or by irreversible database corruption. When corruption occurs, and it can negatively impact your productivity. This course will prepare you by instructing you on best practices for the installation, configuration, and administration of Recovery Manager for Active Directory. At completion of this course you will have the needed skills and knowledge to recover Active Directory in the event of catastrophic forest event or down to recovering a single AD attribute on an AD object.
